### ELFF Software in the near future

With dozens of users in many countries all around the globe we are highly interested in consistently improving our design software. Due to the almost completed design of the Series 1 system and the slow decline in its use in the UK market we are looking forward to implement the new UK Master Series in our ELFF range. Our aim is that the principle of the ELFF functions will not change much, allowing experienced users to use the software right from the implementation of this new series.

### ELFF AutoCAD 2017

On the 30<sup>th</sup> November we were finally able to provide the users with the eagerly awaited ELFF AutoCAD 2017 update. This update contains numerous new features and a material update. ### ELFF User Guide v1.0 2016
